## Registered Building Practitioners are:

- Qualified
- Knowledgeable
- Experienced
- Registered with the Building Practitioners Board
- Covered by appropriate insurance where applicable

## Registration categories include\*:

- Building inspector
- Building surveyor
- Commercial builder
- Domestic builder
- Demolisher
- Draftsperson
- Engineer
- Erector or supervisor of temporary structures
- Quantity surveyor

\*You must use a Registered Building Practitioner for demolition and house removal works regardless of the project cost
